Daniel Waigl is the Executive Director of the Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe (CIRSE). He started his career at the European Congress of Radiology, serving in different positions which included Head of Marketing and Communications, before he left in 2004 to join CIRSE. Daniel has a certification in Marketing and Sales from the Vienna University of Economics Executive Academy.

Founded in 1985, CIRSE is a non-profit, educational and scientific association aiming to improve patient care through the support of teaching, science, research and clinical practice in the field of interventional radiology. In the past 16 years the Society has seen a significant growth in its reach, activities and size. Today CIRSE counts over 8,200 individual academic members and 45 National Group Member societies. In 2021, CIRSE will organise three major educational and scientific conferences: [ECIO – the European Conference on Interventional Oncology](#), April 10-13, which will take place Online; [ET – the European Conference on Embolotherapy](#), June 16-19, Nice, France; and [CIRSE 2021 – The Society's Annual Scientific Congress](#), September 25-29, Lisbon, Portugal.

Other educational activities of the Society include the organisation of [ESIR- the European School of Interventional Radiology](#) courses and the online resources and courses of the [CIRSE Library](#) and the [CIRSE Academy](#).

In 2020 CIRSE has started offering a series of [Webinars](#) focusing on various aspects of interventional radiology practice. In the same year the Society also launched the new proctored version of [the European Board of Interventional Radiology \(EBIR\) exam](#).
